SF Bay Section Plant of the Year, 2015 – UNPLUGGED

The City of Hayward’s Water Pollution Control Facility was recently awarded the San Francisco Bay Section’s Plant of the Year Award for 2105. Also in 2015, the City received the EPA green power leadership award for on-site generation production up to 130% of the plant’s needs using renewable energy sources (solar and biogas). The City ranked 21st in the EPA’s top 30 on-site generation list for partners generating and consuming the most green power on-site for 2015.
