The City of Palo Alto has adopted an ambitious goal to reduce greenhouse gas emissions by 80% of 1990 emissions by the year 2030 - the 80/30 goal. Landfilled food scraps are one of the main contributors to Citywide emissions. Come and learn about how the City of Palo Alto is aggressively working to collect food scraps and developing innovative processing technology at its wastewater treatment plant.

City of Palo Alto Environmental Manager - Zero Waste

Matthew Krupp, Manager of Environmental Control Programs for the Palo Alto's Zero Waste Group, has managed the City of Palo Alto's organics planning efforts, including the implementation of a residential curbside compost collection program and the development of a local energy/compost facility. Previously, Mr. Krupp worked as the project planner on the San Jose/Santa Clara Water Pollution Control Plant Master Plan, a road map for rebuilding the Bay Area's largest wastewater treatment plant and land use plan for the 2,600-acre site. Mr. Krupp holds a Master of Urban Planning degree from the University at Buffalo and is a member of the American Institute of Certified Planners.
